15/043. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- a. Minute No 15/029(a), Blind Summit, Gussage All Saints: There was nothing to report.
- b. **Minute No 15/030(a), Land at Witchampton Village Hall and The Drone:** A letter has been sent to Savills declining the offer of land located behind the Village Hall including the footpath known as the Drone.

15/045. DISTRICT COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

There was no report.

15/046. PARISH CLERK'S REPORT

- a. **Hinton Martell Telephone Kiosk:** It was reported that the contracts have been exchanged on the adoption of the kiosk, though there is no information about when the equipment will be removed.
- b. **Hinton Martell Notice Board:** It was reported that the Village Hall Management Committee have reduced their offer of a grant towards the notice board from £600 to £300. **Refer to the next Parish Council meeting.**
- c. **Parish Council Website:** The Clerk was requested to arrange a meeting of the Website Working Group (Cllr Ms D. White, Cllr Mrs P. Hill, Cllr Mr J. Campbell and the Parish Clerk) with Mr Chris Booth.
- d. Planning Training Session: Councillors reported that the training session on the planning system was very comprehensive and interesting. In future planning decisions will be judged on the level of harm to neighbours and the environment and decisions should be supported by the relevant sections of the Core Strategy and the National Planning Policy. The new electronic system will see the end of paper copies of plans. Plans will be available electronically. This will require a projector and possibly a screen for viewing the plans. The Clerk informed the meeting that she would be attending a briefing at EDDC and would find out if there was likely to be any funding towards acquiring a projector and any other equipment that might be necessary.
- e. Forward Together: from Councillors reported on the County Council plans for working more closely with Town and Parish Councils. The general view was that the larger Towns and Parishes were better able to support the cost of taking on some of the duties currently fulfilled by the County Council. Local Government will be expected to make further substantial cuts in their budgets over the next few years. There will be a follow up meeting to consider devolving responsibilities, Volunteer resourcing and managing demand fo services.
- f. **Road Closure, Witchampton:** Closure of the road between Pound Hill and Dark Lane to allow Sembcorp to carry out service connections. Commencing 29th June until Friday 3rd July
- g. **Road Closure, Witchampton:** Closure of the road between Sheephouse Drove and Old Lawn Farm for carriageway maintenance and re-surfacing. In operation on 15th July 2015 to 21st July 2015 between the hours of 08.00 17.00 daily.
