

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER TARRANT HINTON & THE TARRANT VALLEY AREA (for Great Dorset Steam Fair, 2019)

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic [Temporary Restrictions] Act 1991. The Order is required to facilitate the holding of the Great Dorset Steam Fair [the event] and reduce the disruption to traffic likely to be caused by the Event. The Order will come into effect at 00.01hrs on Friday 16 August 2019 and will be valid until 23.59hrs on Tuesday 27 August 2019.

The following traffic restrictions will be introduced:

1. a 40-mph speed limit will be imposed upon the A354 from Collingwood Corner north eastward to Turnpike Cottage, a distance of approximately 3.25 kilometres;
2. all vehicles will be prohibited from overtaking any other moving vehicle, except for a pedal cycle, on the A354 from Collingwood Corner north eastward to Turnpike Cottage, a distance of approximately 3.25 kilometres;
3. a 30-mph speed limit will be imposed on the C25 (Valley Road) from Tarranthead, Stubhampton southward to Bussey Stool Road, Tarrant Gunville, a distance of approximately 1.3 kilometres;
4. a 30-mph speed limit will be imposed on the C25 (Valley Road) from its junction with the A354 southward to Guppys Cottage, Tarrant Monkton, a distance of approximately 2.8 kilometres.
