Initial community engagement (broad issues)

Provide feedback

Ongoing community engagement (aims, content, detail.)

### 5. BUILDING THE EVIDENCE BASE

Analysis of evidence Complete new evidence Identify gaps in evidence Renew existing evidence

### 6. THEMES, AIMS VISION, OPTIONS

Develop key aims Look at options Prioritise key issues and themes Identify key issues and themes

#### 7. WRITING THE PLAN

Policies, proposals, site allocation Consider sustainability, diversity, equality & delivery
