

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF UNNAMED LANE, LONG CRICHEL

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles, pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders will be prohibited from proceeding along Unnamed Lane, Long Cricchel between Manswood and Cock Road, a distance of approximately 1270 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:30 - 15:00 on 4th August 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4th August 2026.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to carry out pole renewal works in the highway.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
